EXTREMES

Highest: Mt. Carleton reaches 817 metres (2,680 ft).

Lowest: The lowest point is sea level, at the Atlantic Ocean.

Hottest: New Brunswick's temperature reached 39.4°C (103°F) at Nepisiguit Falls on 18 August 1935.

Coldest: The temperature dipped down to -47.2°C (53°F) at Sisson Dam on 1 February 1955.
