## EXTREMES

Beaufort Sea

Lowest: The lowest elevation in the territory is sea level, at the Arctic Ocean.

Coldest: The coldest recorded temperature in North America was in the Yukon on 3 February 1947, when the temperature reached a low of  $-63^{\circ}\text{C}$  ( $-81.4^{\circ}\text{F}$ ) in Snag.

Hottest: The hottest day ever recorded was in Mayo, when the temperature hit  $36.1^{\circ}\text{C}$  ( $97^{\circ}\text{F}$ ) in 1969.

Highest: The Yukon is home to the highest point in Canada. Mount Logan stands at 5,959 metres (19,551 ft) tall.
